**END-OF-YEAR SCHEDULE**

The 2018-2019 Crown Point Central School year is coming to a close! Please refer to the schedule below for important dates.

Beginning **Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup> through Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup>**, our students in grades 7-12 will be taking their final local exams. **The exams will begin at 8:10 and conclude at 3:05pm. A schedule specific to each grade will be distributed to students prior to June 4<sup>th</sup>.** This year, as in the past, our students will only attend school during a scheduled exam or for a class review for a Regents exam. Students in grades 7-12 may be excused from school after an exam only with written parental permission submitted with the time of dismissal in the Main Office. Students who do not bring a written permission will be sent to the library until their next exam. A bus will be available daily at 11:30am to take students home, if they so choose. A bus will also pick up students daily between 11:00-11:30 a.m. for afternoon local exams. **(Students need to sign up in the main office if transportation is needed.)**

On Friday, June 7<sup>st</sup> our elementary will celebrate their 25 Book Campaign Reading Celebration with a Super Hero theme. Also on Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, we will have National Honor Society Inductions and our 7-12 students will receive Junior and Classroom awards beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the gym. Immediately after we will host the CSI (Clean School Initiative) & Reading Celebration for our High School students. We will also have Happy Cows Ice Cream truck to finish off the day.

**Regents exams begin on Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, at 8:30 a.m. through Tuesday, June 25<sup>st</sup>:** Once again, Grades 7-12 students will only attend school for a scheduled Regents exam or review. A bus will be available to pick up those students between 11:30-12:00 p.m. for afternoon Regents exams, which begin at 12:30pm. One bus will also be able to take those students home after their exams are completed. **(Again, students need to sign up in the main office if transportation is needed.)**

**Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup> is Pre-Kindergarten Graduation** Pre-K students will be dismissed for the school year after the ceremony. The ceremony begins at 9:00am. Families of Prekindergarten students will meet in the cafeteria for a reception immediately after the ceremony.

**Beginning on Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, Grades K-6 students will be dismissed daily at 12:00 noon.**

On **Wednesday, June 26<sup>th</sup> Grades K-12 students will receive report cards** before being dismissed at **9:30 a.m.** All students (*except Pre-K*) should attend school on this day.
