



BUDGET VOTE & ELECTION

The Crown Point Central School District Budget Vote and Election is scheduled for **June 9, 2020 - voting will be by Absentee Ballot only.**

A Budget Hearing will take place on June 2, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., for presentation of the Budget.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 202.26 issued on Friday, May 1, 2020 by Governor Andrew Cuomo, all voting for the **June 9, 2020** election will be done by absentee ballot such that the school district must send absentee ballots with a postage paid, return envelope to each "qualified voter." A qualified voter is someone who is a US citizen, 18 years of age, a resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the vote, and not disqualified by any reason set forth in NYS Election Law §5-106.

PERSONAL REGISTRATION

Anyone who meets the definition of a "qualified voter" but has not registered to vote, must do so by May 26, 2020, to receive an absentee ballot. A qualified voter may register with the county or with the School District.
